tism. Meet with a priest to obtain the application form
during parish surgery times.

PLANNING TO GET MARRIED? If you are thinking of
getting married at St Mary's it would be a good idea
first to meet with one of the priests in the parish and
discuss your requirements and the arrangements to be
made. You need to give 6 months notice for your mar-
riage so that all documentation and marriage prepara-
tion courses can be arranged. Look up for Parish Sur-
gery days to discuss your plans with a priest.
