

New Car Parking system



Our new system is now live and is operative

Monday to Friday 24 hour. It covers parking on the forecourt, the parking areas around the parish centre & ramps. **What you have to do**

During the period of operation, if you are attending the parish for any reason, be it service, Mass, surgery or prayer time etc., you will need to log in your car registration at the pad by the shop in the porch area. This is necessary to avoid a parking ticket which is applied for unregistered vehicles. It does **NOT APPLY** on the weekends/for Sunday Masses. At these times, all other usual car parking arrangements remain unchanged, including the charity car park on Saturday daytime run by SVP, reducing your speed, care for pedestrians/ children, disability badge holders and parking safely and considerately at all times given the need for access and our usual use. Thank you for your cooperation.
