**Sessions will begin on time 18:15 – 20:00.** We ask everyone to be punctual for all sessions in consideration of others in your group. If you arrive late, you not only disrupt the class, but you may miss a vital part of the preparation.

We will be adhering to the 2 meter distancing. All candidates will be required to wear a face mask while on the premises.

All candidates must bring their own writing materials as there will be NO lending of items due to Covid-19 restrictions.
